Re: Case 17-G-0011 – In the Matter of a Review of Tariff Provisions Regarding Natural Gas Service to Electric Generators

Dear Secretary Burgess:

Independent Power Producers of New York, Inc. (“IPPNY”) respectfully requests a two-week extension of time to file comments on the Department of Public Service Staff’s Initial Findings Report (“Report”) that was filed in the above-referenced proceeding on January 19, 2017. IPPNY is a not-for-profit trade association representing the independent power industry in New York State. Its members include nearly 75 companies involved in the development, operation and ownership of electric generators and the marketing and sale of electric power in New York’s wholesale and retail electricity markets.

The Secretary’s Notice Soliciting Comments, issued on January 19, 2017, invited interested parties to submit comments on the Report by April 19, 2017. The Report raises significant and complex issues for IPPNY’s members that own and operate natural gas-fired electric generators and take gas transportation service from local distribution companies in New York. The Commission’s decisional process would be aided if additional time were provided to IPPNY and other parties to develop complete and thorough comments in this case. A two-week extension, from April 19 to May 3, will provide IPPNY and its members the necessary time to develop positions in response to the Report.
